REMEMBER, if you are hired by an off-campus employer, the employer will contact Student Financial Services and we will provide the Federal Work Study Authorization Form to the employer. You must sign the Federal Work Study Authorization Form before you begin employment. Though it is not mandatory to enroll in courses during summer to participate in the summer work-study program, you must be planning to re-enroll for the next fall semester. If not enrolled, Federal Work Study earnings from the summer are treated as a resource in your financial aid award for the upcoming academic year.
